Bible Verse of the Month



27 So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.

1 [Jesus said,] "I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. 2 He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes[a] so that it will be even more fruitful. 3 You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. 4 Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither

can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

5 I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. 6 If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. 7 If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples. 9 As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. 10 If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. 11 I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. 12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. 14 You are my friends if you do what I command. 15 I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. 16 You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. 17 This is my command: Love each other."

Friday, January 19, 2024

Members in Attendance: Bob Ridenour, Ferne Ridenour, Rose Mary Oglesby, Susan Wright, Carrie Paradine, Alan Crockett & Jamie Orban

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Susan Wright. Scripture was read by Bob Ridenour: Psalm 27:1. The meeting was called to order at 4:34 p.m. Minutes of December 15, 2023 were reviewed by

the council. A motion to accept the minutes as written was made by Rose Mary Oglesby, seconded by Susan Wright. Motion carried.

COMMITTEES:

FINANCE: Chair Ferne Ridenour reported the following amounts as of December, 2023:

Reuter Trust: \$258,625.11 (up \$4,715.16) as of 12/31/23. The income received on January 1, 2024 was \$688.52 [The principal of the Reuter Trust Fund cannot be used until November 14, 2038.]

Line of Credit: \$4,650.00 (as of December, 2023)

Building Repair Fund: \$90.00 [This fund can only be spent on large building, grounds, and/or equipment repair or replacement costs, as approved by the Church Council.]

Total expenses for the month of December were \$3,175.05 and our total income was \$2,466.07. Expenses exceeded income by a total of \$709.00. Our higher insurance bills were one of the main causes. Our monthly payment has gone up from \$787.62 to \$931.56; that is an extra \$143.62 per month, or \$1,584.00 per year.

FACILITIES & SUPPLIES: Chair Rose Mary Oglesby extended a thank you to Alan Crockett for cleaning snow off of the sidewalks.

PERSONNEL & NOMINATING: No report at this time.

CHURCH GROWTH & NURTURE: Susan Wright reported the following: We mailed out six cards to our church family and friends, two for birthdays and four Christmas cards. Growth and Nurture would like to extend a big thank you to everyone that brought cookies and fruit on December 17 with a special thank you to Betty Norman for delivering them. We are taking down the greens on January 20th at 9 a.m. and hope to see everyone there.

CHRISTIAN DEVELOPMENT: Susan Wright reported that the average adult Christian Education attendance was 0 and the average attendance for our children's classes was 1. Sunday School Bible Study was not held and will not be held unless someone shows an interest in attending. When Jolene was not dancing in and learning from Susan's Biblical plays, she was in Children's Church. Susan and Jolene have decorated the nursery and read about the birth of Jesus, along with completing many activity sheets to decorate the door. Check it out!

PASTOR'S REPORT: No report at this time.

DEACONESS: No report at this time.

ACA REPORT: Susan Wright reported that the American Christian Academy is doing well and had a wonderful Christmas and New Year's vacation. Nathan will have a report card coming out soon, and he is passing all of his classes.

The ACA reported the following accomplishments: We had an enjoyable Christmas party with a movie, many snacks, games, and gifts. due to internet problems with Spectrum, there are not any amounts on how many; and our nonprofit status with the state of Illinois has been approved.

The ACA reported the following goals: File for a 501(C)3 with the IRS; design the sign and purchase posts; and have more students.
